

17 DAY ITINERARY

DAY 1: THURSDAY 22 SEPTEMBER CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA.

Welcome to South Africa! Check in to your hotel and prepare for a fascinating journey.

DAY 2: FRIDAY 23 SEPTEMBER CAPE TOWN.

This morning, a WALKING TOUR introduces you to Cape Town's famous and historic landmarks. Stroll along Government Avenue to see St. George's Cathedral, Parliament, and much more. Next, you'll enter The Company's Garden, a beautiful oasis in the city, en route to Green Market Square, which at different times has point on the African continent. Here, take a FUNICULAR RIDE to the steps of the old lighthouse for spectacular panoramic views. Return to Cape Town and enjoy the evening at your leisure. (B)

NOTE: Each year, generally in early August, the Table Mountain cableway closes for yearly maintenance. During this time, we will visit Signal Hill for views over the city.

DAY 3: SATURDAY 24 SEPTEMBER CAPE TOWN.

Enjoy a full day at leisure for your own discoveries. Perhaps explore the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, take an excursion to the stunning Cape winelands for wine tasting, or cruise to Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela spent 18 of his 27 years in prison. Your Tour Director has suggestions to help you make the most of your day. (B)

DAY 4: SUNDAY 25 SEPTEMBER CAPE TOWN - STONY POINT NATURE RESERVE - HERMANUS - MOSSEL BAY.

This morning, depart Cape Town and drive to STONY POINT NATURE RESERVE to see a COLONY OF ENDANGERED AFRICAN PENGUINS. Known for the unique sound they make, these penguins grow to an average height of two feet and live in burrows and rock crevices along the beach. Stop in Hermanus for independent exploration before reaching Mossel Bay for the evening. (B)

DAY 5: MONDAY 26 SEPTEMBER MOSSEL BAY - OUDTSHOORN KNYSNA.

Drive north to Oudtshoorn and stop for a visit of the CANGO CAVES to see the stunning limestone rock formations. You will also visit a local OSTRICH FARM. Continue on to Knysna. (B,L)

DAY 6: TUESDAY 27 SEPTEMBER KNYSNA.

Today, take a relaxing CRUISE on Knysna Lagoon to see a variety of bird and marine life. You will have some free time to explore the Knysna waterfront in the afternoon. (B)

DAY 7: WEDNESDAY 28 SEPTEMBER KNYSNA - TSITSIKAMMA NATIONAL PARK - DURBAN - UMHLANGA.

This morning, visit nearby TSITSIKAMMA NATIONAL PARK and walk through the spectacular coastal forest. Continue on to Port Elizabeth, where you will board your flight to Durban. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel in nearby Umhlanga for the evening. (B)

DAY 8: THURSDAY 29 SEPTEMBER UMHLANGA-SHAKALAND-HLUHLUWE.

Today, visit SHAKALAND, a replica of a traditional Zulu homestead and living monument to their culture. Here, learn more about Zulu history and see how they hand craft ceramics and brew beer. This afternoon, drive to Hluhluwe. (B,L,D)

DAY 9: FRIDAY 30 SEPTEMBER **HLUHLUWE**.

This morning, take a GAME DRIVE in HluhluweiMfolozi Park, the oldest proclaimed wildlife reserve in all of Africa. The park is home to the "Big 5"—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino, and Cape buffalo. You also have the chance to see giraffe, zebra, wildebeest, and much more! After time to rest, embark on an AFTERNOON BOAT RIDE on Lake St. Lucia, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. During the cruise, you are likely to spot hippo, Nile crocodile, and a variety of bird life. (B,D)

DAY 10: SATURDAY 1 OCTOBER **HLUHLUWE-ESWATINI.**

Today, drive to eSwatini. En route, stop at a LOCAL MARKET and visit a GLASS FACTORY where glass blowers use recycled glass to create stemware, animals, and more. (B)

DAY 11: SUNDAY 2 OCTOBER ESWATINI-KRUGER NATIONAL PARK AREA.

Depart eSwatini and head north for the Kruger area. Enjoy leisure time at your lodge this afternoon in preparation for your day of game viewing in the world-renowned Kruger National Park tomorrow. (B,L,D)

DAY 12: MONDAY 3 OCTOBER KRUGER AREA.

Rise between 5 am and 5:30 am for coffee and tea before your EARLY MORNING GAME DRIVE with an experienced guide. If the timing is right, you might spot some of the big cats after a night of hunting. Spend some time at leisure in the middle of the day. Perhaps book a spa treatment or simply relax at the pool. Be sure to watch for kudu, impala, giraffe, cheetah, spotted hyena, and more on your AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE. As darkness descends, your guide will bring out a spotlight to help you spot nocturnal animals. Return to your lodge for dinner. (B,L,D)

DAY 13: TUESDAY 4 OCTOBER KRUGER AREA-MPUMALANGA.

Today, drive along the PANORAMIC ROUTE known for its dramatic landscapes. Along the way, drive through Blyde River Canyon and stop to see GOD'S WINDOW, the THREE RONDAVELS, and BOURKE'S LUCK POTHOLES with its stunning rock formations carved by the Blyde River. (B)

DAY 14: WEDNESDAY 5 OCTOBER MPUMALANGA-PRETORIA-JOHANNESBURG-DEPARTURE.

Drive to Pretoria to see the Voortrekker Monument and Union Buildings. Continue on to Johannesburg where you will overnight at a hotel close to the airport. (B)

DAY 15: THURSDAY 6 OCTOBER JOHANNESBURG-VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE.

Today, leave South Africa and fly north to Zimbabwe. This evening, enjoy a CRUISE on the Zambezi River, which affords you a great opportunity to photograph wildlife and a spectacular African sunset! (B)

DAY 16: FRIDAY 7 OCTOBER VICTORIA FALLS.

Today, visit mighty VICTORIA FALLS for an awe-inspiring experience. Enjoy a GUIDED WALK, where you will learn the history of the falls and hear fascinating details about the surrounding flora and fauna. (B)

NOTE: During the dry season (Sept.-Dec.), and during particularly dry years, water flow to Victoria Falls may be low.

DAY 17: SATURDAY 8 OCTOBER VICTORIA FALLS- JOHANNESBURGDEPARTURE.

Your tour ends with a flight back to Johannesburg to connect with your homebound flight. Book homebound flights after 5:30 pm. (B)
